

The Virginia Tech Mathematics Department invites applications for full-time instructor positions to start in the Fall of 2017. The initial appointments will be one-year restricted appointments, with possibility of renewal. The primary duties are teaching undergraduate classes. For some of the positions, these classes may include classes for pre-service teachers or Math Emporium classes. A masters degree in mathematics or a masters degree in a related field with a concentration in mathematics is required. Exceptionally qualified candidates may be considered for other instructional positions or for different terms of appointment. Online applications include a resume/CV, cover letter, and candidate statement addressing the candidate's teaching philosophy.
