**Goal:** Hokie Mentorship Connect Ambassadors work to support the initiatives of Hokie Mentorship Connect including tasks assigned as part of the onboarding and outreach process of helping participants utilize the platform. Duties will include working to market the program on behalf of Career and Professional Development through event attendance and participation. Mentorship Ambassadors will work closely with the Assistant Director – Mentorship Program to create supplemental programming, staff events, provide onboarding assistance, create innovative marketing ideas, and increase user engagement. This position offers an excellent opportunity for students to build experience with student leadership, cultural competency and gain valuable professional experience.

## • Professional Competencies Based

- Leadership: Leverage strengths to motivate, collaborate and guide. The ability to use a positive attitude to influence and empower others to reach a shared goal through strategic thinking and effective decision-making.
- Digital Fluency: Maximize new and emerging technologies in order to work, lean and live in a digital society. The ability to apply digital technology to enhance quality, improve productivity and communication, solve problems and streamline processes.
- Creativity and Problem-Solving: Exercise sound reasoning to analyze issues, synthesize information, make decisions and solve problems. The ability to think critically and strategically to develop original ideas and innovative solutions.
- Teamwork & Interpersonal: Build and maintain collaborative relationships to work effectively with others in a team setting through shared responsibility, empathy and respect. The ability to manage your emotions and conflict with others while contributing towards a common goal.
- Communication: Articulate thoughts and express ideas effectively using oral, written, visual and non-verbal communication skills, as well as listening to gain understanding. The ability to deliver information in person, in wiring and in a digital world.

### Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Assist with the development and posting of marketing content including presentations, event flyers and/or video recordings. The goal of marketing is to grow awareness of Hokie Mentorship Connect to generate increased enrollment of program participants.
- Assist with preparing, maintaining materials for "Orientation Sessions" and with tracking the attendees.
- Work collaboratively with other Mentorship Ambassador to identify and plan outreach/marketing opportunities to increase student enrollment in **Hokie Mentorship Connect**.
- Represent **Hokie Mentorship Connect** by leading or co-leading presentations, workshops or events to discuss **Hokie Mentorship Connect**.
- Assist with the planning and implementation of other mentorship sponsored activities held throughout the year.
